Year-Long Campaign Kicked Off at the 2009 National Training Program

We know that Hurricane Katrina destroyed many of the schools in the New Orleans' 9th Ward and other areas of the city, as well. We also know that there are daily struggles that so many families are confronted with and we know that it is especially important for us to reach out to one another and offer a helping hand. So, Federally Employed Women (FEW) is reaching out to give back with a year-long initiative to adopt two schools in the New Orleans, Louisiana, area and provide needy children with resources they so greatly need, such as books, supplies and uniforms. Our goal is to raise a minimum of \$5,000.00 for each school. This initiative will culminate with FEW's 2010 National Training Program being held in New Orleans July 12-16, 2010.

Because the need is still so great four years after the Hurricane Katrina, FEW is adopting two schools in the New Orleans Public School System - McDonogh #35 College Preparatory Senior High School and Mary Bethune Elementary Literature/Technology School.

New Orleans's McDonogh #35 College Preparatory Senior High School serves grades 7-12 in the Orleans Parish School District. McDonogh #35 strives to develop students into a new generation of leaders who possess a love for truth, the critical intelligence to pursue it and the courage to articulate it. Their mission statement is to encourage academic excellence for all students in challenging and interactive programs that are supported by teachers, staff, students, parents and communities.

Mary Bethune Elementary Literature/Technology is a public school that serves grades PK-6 in the Orleans Parish School District, and its mission is to

develop lifelong learners by providing rigorous and relevant learning experiences through literature, mathematics and technology.
